



The Douglas Bomford Trust Scholarship Application 2016/17

The Douglas Bomford Trust (DBT) Scholarship is open to **all BEng/ MEng/ BSc or FdSc Engineering** students studying at Harper Adams University **up to graduate level**.

The Douglas Bomford Trust offers a scholarship which is primarily aimed at **Agricultural Engineering** students; however, they have been known, by exception, to offer scholarships to students on other engineering courses as well. The Trust may award **up to five** scholarships.

Please note this scholarship is not exclusive to Harper Adams.

The successful scholarship recipient(s) **may** be awarded funds individually based on merit typically up to a maximum value of **£1,500** for one year only, although higher payments can be made in exceptional circumstances. The award will be payable to the successful recipient(s) in two equal parts; half to be paid in February 2017 and the balance in May 2017.

Payment is conditional on the scholar remaining registered as a full-time student at Harper Adams. They must pass all modules of study during the continuation of the scholarship and submit at least one written report to the Development Trust prior to the receipt of their second payment.

This is a competitive award which will be evaluated on the merit of the submitted application, academic achievements to date and interview. The decision of the DBT Scholarship Panel is **FINAL** and they reserve the right to withdraw the award at any time should they feel this action is required.

Shortlisted applicants are required to attend a panel interview at HAU on **Thursday 17 November 2016**.

Please note that an alternative interview date cannot be arranged.

Application Process

- On A4 paper, (no more than 2 pages) single-sided sheets, (**font NO smaller than Arial 11**) explain why you would be interested in receiving a scholarship from the Douglas Bomford Trust. It is **essential** that you put forward a case as to why you have come to the Trust for a scholarship.
- Include a brief CV - **maximum of 2 pages, single sided, font Arial 11**. Do not staple your application.

It is a mandatory requirement of the Douglas Bomford Trust that a scholarship recipient is required to submit a report back to the Trust advising them of how the scholarship has been spent.

In the event, that the Douglas Bomford Trust Scholarship panel requests UCAS and/or academic information to assess your application, your authorisation and signature are required. In addition, this allows HAU and the sponsor to publicise your scholarship. Please indicate your consent below:
